



reconstruction and conversion House 'N' family home, Bonn



the project

The detached house with granny flat was built in 1975 and is extensively renovated and rebuilt. A part of the measures is the development of the so far unused pointed bottom. Due to the hillside location, the building is two-storey facing the street, but only one-storey on the garden side. The ground floor of the building is accessed laterally via an external staircase. The granny flat in the basement is at street level.

The pointed floor is expanded as a loft floor with bedroom and lounge. The loft floor is accessed by installing a wooden staircase.

Roof windows are installed for optimal lighting of the new areas.

The roof is being energetically renovated and re-covered. The loggia facing the street is converted into a winter garden. The partial demolition and relocation of non-load-bearing walls creates spacious living areas and an open structure
